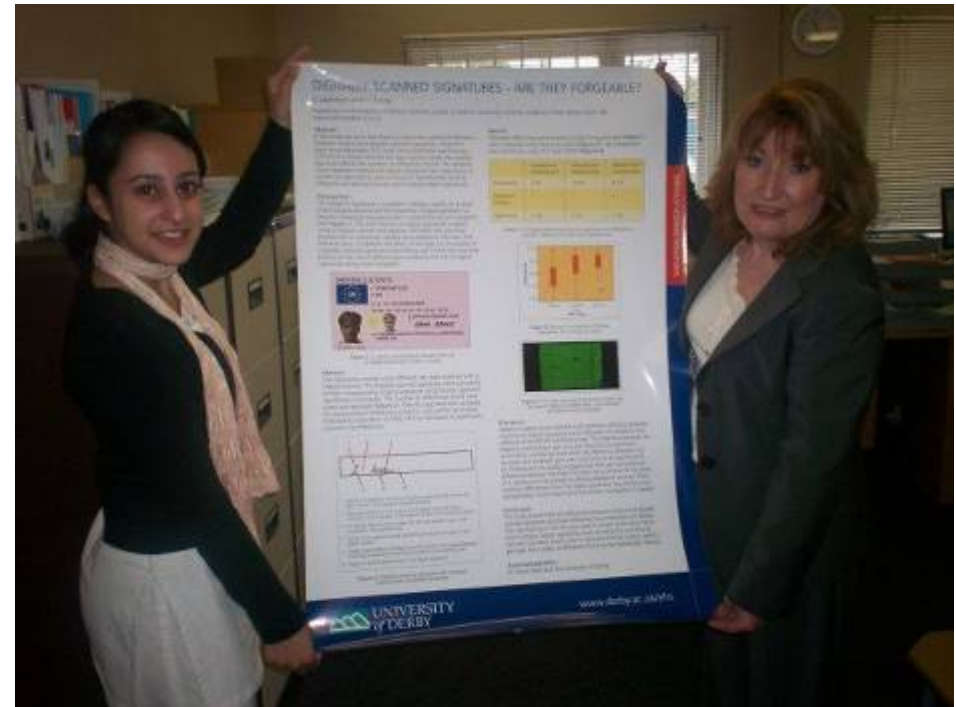
How to do it
